Dear Secretary Gee:

As Clerk of the Senate, I have been directed by Senator Aaron R. Rouse, Chair of the Senate Committee on Privileges and Election, to advise you that the Committee met on Monday, June 9, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. and at that time failed to report Senate Joint Resolution SJR 6001.

SJR 6001 contained the names of 8 gubernatorial appointments. Pursuant to Article V, Section 11 of the *Constitution of Virginia*, "No person appointed to any office by the Governor, whose appointment is subject to confirmation by the General Assembly, under the provisions of this Constitution or any statute, shall enter upon, or continue in, office after the General Assembly shall have refused to confirm his appointment, nor shall such person be eligible for reappointment during the recess of the General Assembly to fill the vacancy caused by such refusal to confirm."

As a result of the failure to report SJR 6001 by the Senate Committee on June 9, 2025, their action is effective immediately.
